## NET-METERING APPLICATION PROCESS

- Member must complete the application for interconnection and provide specification sheets for the panels and inverters, a wiring diagram, and a site plan.

- The application and supporting documents will be reviewed by OBEC's engineering department. Approval or feedback for any corrections needed will be given within 30 days for less than a 10kW system and within 90 days for larger systems.
- Any upgrades to OBEC's system required to accommodate the installation and/or engineering studies for systems over 10kW will be discussed and done at the member's cost.
- Once initial approval is given you can proceed with the installation. When installation is complete, submit the following items:
  - post-construction certification signed by the professional engineer/electrician
  - pictures of the installation, including the open disconnect and wiring to the meter base
  - A two-way metering fee of \$250.
  - Certificate of insurance (for systems 10kW and larger)
- OBEC will schedule an inspection and meter change. Someone will need to be on location that is able to operate the equipment to complete the inspection.
